## TRACKING ACCESS MEASURES

The University of Poonch Rawalakot diligently tracks and monitors the enrollment and completion rates of students by gender. In 2021, women accounted for $59.05 \%$ of the student population (as indicated in Table-1). During the 2018-19 academic year, female graduates represented $52.68 \%$ of all graduates. Over the past four years, there has been a consistent increase in the number of female students graduating. These statistics highlight that female students have been outnumbering their male counterparts at the University of Poonch Rawalakot. This upward trend in women's education is largely attributed to the university's efforts in fostering gender equality. The persistence of this trend is expected to significantly influence the composition of the future workforce.
