UPR leaders have been actively involved formation of Poverty Alleviation and Social Policy and related issues by conducting research, offering technical advice, and providing policy briefs. Our Vice-Chancellor has been part of the review Board of the Ministry of Poverty Alleviation and Social Safety since 2018, his contributions to the design of Social Safety Net for Marginalized and Socially excluded masses have been adopted as the guidelines for the executers of Social Protection and Safety Net Programs.

Similarly, the Vice Chancellor offers policy advice to Pakistan Bait ul Mall, Government of Pakistan to develop policies and programs for orphans, homeless, and street children. Under the leadership guidance, the university has developed a tracking mechanism for these children across Pakistan which is adopted as an implementation tool by the Department of Social Welfare and Zakat in all the provinces of the country. Our Vice-Chancellor has also helped design policies for the Bait ul Mall Department of the Government of Pakistan to reach out to the destitute, transgender, and people with disabilities.
